Safe Cities: Terrorism Readiness and Response

With the emergence of terrorist groups over the years and the increase of so-called "lone-wolf" individuals determined to harm others, especially the civilian population, the threat has increased significantly and it has become harder to anticipate and interdict their activities. It has therefore become more important than ever for authorities to have an effective and comprehensive approach to maintaining public safety and security. Whilst many organizations do indeed follow the basic precepts of Prepare, Prevent, Respond and Recover, they nonetheless remain vulnerable in a number of key areas.

This presentation highlights some of the key difficulties organizations face when dealing with active threat incidents and will share some best practices and strategies for ensuring a fully capable and competent response to any emerging or ongoing active threat incident.

Enhanced Air Cargo Security

With the change of Policy Direction from the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) to enhance air cargo security, the Hong Kong Government has tightened its Regulated Air Cargo Agents Regime (RAR) requirement to meet the changes. As a result, demands for cargo screening are expected to surge significantly.

Ensuring sufficient screening capacity and giving due consideration to cargo movements efficiency, Hong Kong Government has rolled out a Regulated Air Cargo Screening Facilities (RACSF) Scheme last year to facilitate cargo screening at the off-airport locations. While the tightening of air cargo security is a big challenge to the industry, G4S Secure Solutions (Hong Kong) Limited has taken up the challenge with its business partners and made it an opportunity to expand its commitment to the air cargo industry.
